Southern Africa Safari

Day One:

Today upon your arrival at the Cape Town International Airport, you will be met by an Indulge Africa representative for a road transfer to the Cape Grace hotel. This road transfer will take approximately 30 minutes.

Cape Grace Hotel

Day Two:

This morning after breakfast your guide will collect you for a full day private guided Cape Point Tour.



Cape Point Tour

While driving via the False Bay coastline you will pass through Muizenberg Beach, Cecil John Rhodes's cottage, the brightly painted Victorian bathing booths at St James and the fishing hamlet of Kalk Bay. Stop to visit the resident Jackass Penguin colony (one of the only land-based colonies) at the nearby Boulders beach, one of the prettiest beaches on the peninsula with its big granite boulders and azure waters.

Continue along the coastal route to the Cape of Good Hope – the most south-westerly tip of Africa, where the cold Benguela and warm Mozambique currents meet. The landscapes at Cape Point are dramatic and the sea wild. Return to Cape Town via scenic Chapman's Peak drive, a winding cliff-hanging road carved into the mountainside.

Day Three:

Enjoy the day at leisure. You may choose to participate in the many wonderful activities that Cape Town and the surrounding area has to offer. This afternoon your guide will collect you from the hotel for sundowners on Table Mountain.

Cable Ride up Table Mountain:

Enjoy a cableway ride to the famous Table Mountain. The cableway ride only takes 2 minutes to climb up the 1087m high peak. This breathtaking view overlooks the city, the Twelve Apostles, Camps Bay and the Cape Peninsula.

Day Four:

Early this morning you will be transferred to the Cape Town International Airport from where your domestic flight to Johannesburg will depart at 6:00am. Upon your arrival at the Johannesburg International Airport, you will be met by a representative and assisted with boarding your regional flight on Air Botswana to Maun departing at 10:00am.

Upon your arrival at the Maun airport you will be met by a Wilderness Safaris representative and assisted with boarding your scheduled charter flight from Maun to Kings Pool. At the Kings Pool Airstrip you will be met by your guide for a short road transfer to the camp!

Kings Pool Camp

Kings Pool camp is located in the Linyanti Wildlife Reserve, bordering the western boundary of the Chobe National Park. The camp overlooks the Kings Pool Lagoon and the Linyanti River. The private reserve is characterized by open grasslands, Mopane and mixed terminalia woodlands, riverine forest and the now dry Savuti Channel.



Kings Pool Lagoon was apparently named after a Scandinavian monarch who spent a number of nights camping out on the banks of the lagoon, long before the camp was built here. The Linyanti area has a large wildlife resource with a wide variety of species, but it is most noted for its very large Elephant population, which can reach enormous densities during our winter months.

Overnight stay at Kings Pool Cam in a luxury suite on a full board basis

Day Five:

Upon return from the morning game drive, enjoy a sumptuous breakfast at Kings Pool Camp. The remainder of the morning is at leisure. Lunch is followed by leisure time and an opportunity to enjoy an afternoon siesta. Join your camp manager and guide for high tea before the afternoon/evening safari. Dinner is an African affair!

Day Six:

Head out in the early morning on safari drive. Enjoy a sumptuous breakfast at Kings Pool Camp upon return from the morning game drive. The remainder of the morning, lunch and the early afternoon is at leisure. Join your camp manager and guide for high tea before the afternoon/evening safari and return to camp in the early evening for dinner.

Overnight stay at Kings Pool Camp in a luxury suite on a full board basis

Day Seven:

This morning after you game activity, breakfast and check out you will depart with a scheduled charter flight to Maun. Upon your arrival at the Maun airport you will be met by a Wilderness Safaris representative who will assist you with checking in for your regional flight to Windhoek. Upon arrival at the Windhoek International Airport you will be met by an And Beyond Africa representative who will assist you with a scheduled charter flight to Sossusvlei Mountain Lodge.

Upon arrival at the Sossusvlei Mountain Lodge Airstrip you will be met by your guide for a transfer to the lodge.

Day Eight:

Head out in the early morning for your morning safari activity. Enjoy a sumptuous breakfast at Sossusvlei Mountain Lodge upon return from your morning activity. The remainder of the morning, lunch and the early afternoon is at leisure. Your afternoon/evening safari follows high tea this afternoon. Return to camp in the early evening for dinner.

Sossusvlei Mountain Lodge

Experience the haunting beauty of the Namib Desert at Sossusvlei Mountain Lodge, situated in the foothills of the private NamibRand Nature Reserve in Namibia. Thanks to conservation efforts, the NamibRand spans 180 000 hectares (445 000 acres) of pristine desert wilderness, and is the largest private nature reserve in Southern Africa. The Namib – known as ‘The Living Desert’ – is a world of vast space, endless horizons, dramatic desertscapes and jagged mountain heights.

This extraordinary safari lodge is renowned for its luxurious and private accommodation set at the foot of a mountain overlooking the stark, yet beautiful Namib Desert. Designed to capture the splendour and solitude of the desert, each stone and glass desert villa is set along the curve of the escarpment, affording absolute privacy. Each villa features a shaded private veranda, split-level bedroom and living room with fireplace, fully-stocked personal bar, compact spotting scope and a service-intercom to the main lodge.

Activities Included:

Exhilarating game drives

CC Africa’s resident naturalists will lead you on scenic game drives in open 4x4 vehicles, exploring the grass plains and red sand dune belts of the NamibRand Nature Reserve. See rare wildlife like the oryx antelope and mountain zebra.

Quadbiking

Exploring the sand dunes on quadbikes is an unforgettable desert experience. These excursions are guided to ensure minimal impact on the dune habitat.

Interpretive wilderness walks

As many of the desert’s attractions are small and well camouflaged, guided and marked walking trails offer the perfect opportunity to experience this fascinating desert landscape on foot.

Stargazing

Traverse magnificent desert skies from the Lodge’s private observatory, boasting the most powerful electronic telescope in Namibia apart from the National Observatory. Sossusvlei’s resident astronomer will ensure that you receive an unforgettable cosmic experience.



Optional activities at additional cost:

Hot-air balloon safaris and scenic flights

Hot-air balloon safaris over the Namib (weather permitting) offer unparalleled views of the desert's sea of red sand dunes – an once-in-a-lifetime experience



Skeleton Coast Safari by air

Catch a small plane flight that takes you for a 3 to 4 hour flight to the Skeleton Coast, aptly named for the many shipwrecks along this coastline. A safari in the Skeleton Coast National Park offers more than 5000 square kilometres/1930 square miles of Namib Desert featuring wind-hewn dunes, rugged canyons and jagged mountain peaks.



Day Nine:

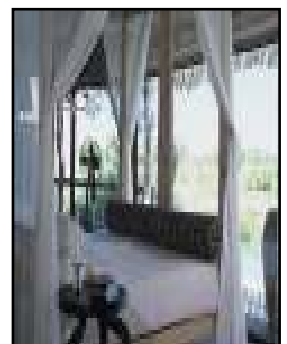
This morning after your game activity (time permitting), breakfast and check out, your guide will transfer you to the Sossusvlei Airstrip from where your scheduled charter flight will depart to Windhoek International Airport. Here you will be assisted with boarding your regional flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival at the Johannesburg International Airport you will depart on a private charter flight to Singita. Upon your arrival at the Singita airstrip you will be met by your guide for a short road transfer to Singita Boulders Lodge where you will be assisted with check in for your four night stay.

Singita

Singita, meaning 'the Miracle' in the local Shangaan language - is exquisite luxury, rare solitude and perfect tranquility in a jewel-like setting where dedicated, professional staff seek to pamper and please you. World-class comfort, style, food and rare vintage wines stroke the senses and exclusive accommodation for the discerning traveler.

Boulders Lodge towers over the landscape, a monolith of curving thatch and piled stone that joins seamlessly with the rocky geometry that holds it to the earth. Senufo artefacts and bold sculpture offset smooth linen in blue and silent white, as cascading water cools the summer air. Boulders Lodge rests on the banks of the Sand River in the heart of the Singita Private Game Reserve, unlocking the senses to views that stretch to the edges of the imagination. Singita Boulders' suites feature magnificent stone bathrooms and bedrooms that encapsulate in luxury. Quiet, simple and luxurious, moments spent on the vast sundecks at Boulders Lodge will leave you at the mercy of the breathtaking wild distance.



Day Ten & Eleven:

After senses are awakened by the sounds of the bushveld, you will congregate with the rangers at the main lodge for tea, coffee and light snacks in anticipation of the early morning game drive. As the early morning sun rises over the horizon, rangers and trackers head out with guests into the African bushveld. One can sense the excitement... who knows what to expect? The sound of creatures awakening to a new day stirs your passion for Africa and its many wonders.

The fresh aromas of Singita's signature breakfast entice you back to the lodge. Overlooking the African plains from the main deck, a spectacular breakfast follows your return from the morning game drive, with a buffet of seasonal fruits, cereals, yoghurts and fruit juice, followed by a delectable hot breakfast. At your leisure - whether an indulgent massage or beauty treatment at the spa, relaxing under an African sun on your sundeck, a workout at the gym or some superb shopping at the trading store, any number of discoveries await. After spending the morning at leisure, Singita's talented chefs prepare a medley of culinary delights for lunch, inspired by African flavours yet guided by western cooking tradition.

As the endless African day starts to cool and the shadows are forming across the plains, you will enjoy afternoon refreshments, which are served in the main lodge before the evening game drive. A vivid sunset sky forms the backdrop of an unforgettable wildlife experience. As darkness approaches, the animals become more active, rarely seen nocturnal creatures emerge and incredible interactions are the order of the day. Pause midway for drinks and conversation as the sun disappears at one of the many vantage points hidden in the bush. The evening drive is the apex of the African adventure, moments that will define forever your memories of Africa. One by one, the drivers return to the lodge, the fires are lit and the night's entertainment begins.

Return to the lodge for dinner around the fire in the Boma under a starlit sky, or a gourmet meal by candlelight in the dining room. A fusion of venison dishes, fresh fish from the South African coast, pastas, soups and vegetables, dinner at Singita is a sumptuous affair, where you will be enchanted by the rhythm and harmony of a local choir. Retire to your suite for a restful nights sleep in preparation for the next exciting day.
